"Glorifying God & Enjoying Him Forever." "May it be that through the Church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known" – Ephesians 3:10 "My Dear LORD, I can but tell thee that thou knowest I long for nothing but thyself, nothing but holiness, nothing but union with thy will. #### Gospel Lesson

#### Colossians 2:8-10; 1 John 4:1-3

<sup>8</sup> See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ. <sup>9</sup> For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, <sup>10</sup> and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. <sup>2</sup> By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, <sup>3</sup> and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you heard was coming and now is in the world already.

# Sermon: Ecclesiastes 11

"Meditating upon Our Legacy"

(If able, please stand for the reading of God's word) Rev. Justin Westmoreland

1 Cast your bread upon the waters,

- for you will find it after many days.
- <sup>2</sup> Give a portion to seven, or even to eight, for you know not what disaster may happen on earth.
- <sup>3</sup> If the clouds are full of rain, they empty themselves on the earth, and if a tree falls to the south or to the north,

in the place where the tree falls, there it will lie.

<sup>4</sup> He who observes the wind will not sow, and he who regards the clouds will not reap.

<sup>5</sup> As you do not know the way the spirit comes to the bones in the womb of a woman with child, so you do not know the work of God who makes everything.

<sup>6</sup>In the morning sow your seed, and at evening withhold not your hand, for you do not know which will prosper, this or that, or whether both alike will be good.

<sup>7</sup>Light is sweet, and it is pleasant for the eyes to see the sun.

<sup>8</sup> So if a person lives many years, let him rejoice in them all; but let him remember that the days of darkness will be many. All that comes is vanity.

<sup>9</sup>Rejoice, O young man, in your youth, and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth. Walk in the ways of your heart and the sight of your eyes. But know that for all these things God will bring you into judgment.

<sup>10</sup> Remove vexation from your heart, and put away pain from your body, for youth and the dawn of life are vanity.

Minister: This is the Word of the Lord. **People: Thanks be to God!** 

Big Idea: The Preacher is meditating upon the vanity of seeking meaning in life without regard to God. As he closes, having made a case for his hearers to repent of folly and seek wisdom, Solomon commends his hearers to concern themselves with building a legacy in light of God's power, control, and presence in their lives.
